The Denver Fire Department (DFD) is requesting approval of the proposed purchase of a Pierce Velocity Pumper (engine) and Pierce Velocity 105' Aerial (truck) from Pierce Manufacturing, Inc. to support fire protection and other emergency response services within the City of Englewood. The fire engine will be funded through the General Fund appropriations (01010-3522100) assigned to DFD and the fire truck will be funded through the City's Planned Fleet Replacement Fund (11804-5053400). Vehicle expenditures will be offset with 2015 revenue (approx. \$3.1M) from the City of Englewood.

In 2015, the City entered into an Intergovernmental Agreement with the City of Englewood to provide fire protection services. The Fire Department is requesting approval to purchase a fire engine and fire truck to support emergency response services within this jurisdiction. The cost of the fire engine is approximately \$486,803 and will be funded through General Fund appropriations (01010-3522100) assigned to DFD. The cost of a fire truck is approximately \$1,000,000 and will be funded through the City's Planned Fleet Replacement Fund (11804-5053400). Vehicle expenditures will be offset with 2015 revenue (\$3.1M) from the City of Englewood.
