

THIRD AMENDATORY EQUIPMENT RENTAL AGREEMENT

THIS THIRD AMENDATORY EQUIPMENT RENTAL AGREEMENT is made between the **CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER**, a home rule and municipal corporation of the State of Colorado (the “City” or “Customer”) and **BIG TRUCK RENTAL, LLC**, a Florida limited liability company, authorized to do business in Colorado, whose address is 4221 W. Boy Scout Blvd., Suite 400, Tampa, Florida 33607 (the “Company”), jointly (“the Parties”).

RECITALS:

A. The Parties entered into an Equipment Rental Agreement dated December 27, 2022, an Amendatory Agreement dated January 24, 2023, a Second Amendatory Equipment Rental Agreement dated April 19, 2023 (collectively, the “Agreement”) to rent certain Equipment by the City (as defined in the Agreement) from the Company.

B. The Parties wish to amend the Agreement to extend the term, update paragraph 6, increase the maximum contract amount, update paragraph 9, amend the scope of work and budget exhibit, and update the maintenance service plans exhibit.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and the Parties’ mutual covenants and obligations, the Parties agree as follows:

1. Section 5 of the Agreement entitled “**TERM**,” is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with:

“**5. TERM**. The term of this Agreement shall commence upon on **December 27, 2022**, (“Date of Execution”) and shall expire on **December 31, 2024** (the “Term”), unless terminated earlier as provided hereinafter. The term of this Agreement may be extended by the City under the same terms and conditions by a written amendment to this Agreement. Subject to the Executive Director’s prior written authorization, the Company shall complete any work in progress as of the expiration date and the Term of the Agreement will extend until the work is completed or earlier terminated by the Executive Director.”

2. Section 6 of the Agreement entitled “**COMPENSATION AND PAYMENT**.” Subsections **A.** and **B.** is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with:

“A. In consideration for the Rental by Company to City of the Equipment, City agrees to pay base rental payments and other charges as specified on the attached **Exhibit A** and **Exhibit C** in this Agreement.

B. Notwithstanding any other provision of the Agreement, the total compensation payable by the City to Company under this Agreement shall not exceed **THREE MILLION NINE HUNDRED SIXTY-EIGHT THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED NINETY-FOUR DOLLARS AND FIFTY CENTS (\$3,968,794.50)** (the “Maximum Contract Amount”). The City is not obligated to execute an Agreement or any amendments for anything beyond that specifically described in **Exhibit A** and **Exhibit C**. Any services performed or items provided beyond those in **Exhibit A** or **Exhibit C** are performed and provided at Company’s risk and without authorization under the Agreement.”

3. Section 9 of the Agreement entitled “**MAINTENANCE; REPAIR; TIRE WEAR**,” is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with:

“9. **MAINTENANCE; REPAIR; TIRE WEAR**.

a. As the Executive Director directs, the Company shall diligently undertake, perform, and complete all of the services and produce all the deliverables set forth on **Exhibit C, Maintenance Service Plan**, to the City’s satisfaction.

b. The Company is ready, willing, and able to provide the services required by this Agreement.

c. The Company shall faithfully perform the services in accordance with the standards of care, skill, training, diligence, and judgment provided by highly competent individuals performing services of a similar nature to those described in the Agreement and in accordance with the terms of the Agreement.”

4. All references in the original Agreement to **Exhibit A, Scope of Work and Budget** now refer to **Exhibit A, Exhibit A-1** and **Exhibit A-2**. **Exhibit A-2** is attached and incorporated by reference herein.

5. All references in the original Agreement to **Exhibit C, Service Plan** now refer to **Exhibit C** and **Exhibit C-1**. **Exhibit C-1** is attached and incorporated by reference herein.

6. As herein amended, the Agreement is affirmed and ratified in each and every particular.

7. This Third Amendatory Equipment Rental Agreement will not be effective or binding on the City until it has been fully executed by all required signatories of the City and County of Denver, and if required by Charter, approved by the City Council.

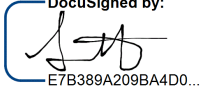

MAINTENANCE SERVICE PLAN

HEAVY DUTY TRUCK PREVENTATIVE MAINTENANCE INSPECTION SERVICE LEVELS (see attached form for specifics at each level)

A Service: performed at every 150-hour interval is an inspection and greasing. If any items are noted as defective, Big Truck Rental, LLC will be responsible for replacing/fixing them if it is a warranty related item. If it is noticed during the inspection that a daily wear item needs to be replaced (such as a wiper blade, belt, hose, etc.), that will be the responsibility of the City.

B Service: performed at every 600-hour interval, Big Truck Rental, LLC will perform the A inspection along with an oil change and fuel filter change

C Service: performed at every 1200-hour interval, Big Truck Rental, LLC will check the hydraulic system

D Service: performed at every 2400-hour interval, Big Truck Rental, LLC will change the power steering fluid

E Service: performed at every 3000-hour interval, Big Truck Rental, LLC will change the transmission fluid/filters

C-1 is for the Rental Plan Period of 1/1/2024 to 12/31/2024.

Specific costs for these maintenance plan services are reflected in Exhibit A-2 for the above rental plan period.
