7 **For an ordinance amending Section 2-145 of the Revised Municipal Code**
8 **concerning adjustments to the membership of the Mayor's Commission On**
9 **Youth.**

11 **WHEREAS**, the mayor's commission on youth, among other activities, provides advice and
12 recommendations on programs and issues concerning youth, ages 12-18, living in the City and
13 County of Denver; and

14 **WHEREAS**, the commission has determined it is necessary to increase and adjust its
15 membership in order to reflect more diverse segments of the youth population in the City and
16 County of Denver and to provide more opportunities to engage youth in the commission's business
17 affairs;

18 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

19 **Section 1.** That subsection A.2. of Section 2-145 of the D.R.M.C., is hereby amended by
20 deleting the language stricken and adding the language underlined to read as follows:

21 **Sec. 2-145. Advisory groups.**

23 A. *Mayor's Youth Commission.* An advisory commission to be known as the Mayor's
24 Youth Commission is hereby created.

25
26 2. *Membership.* The mayor's youth commission shall consist of
27 ~~twenty one (21)~~ twenty-eight (28) members. All members of
28 the mayor's youth commission shall be appointed by and
29 shall serve at the pleasure of the mayor. The membership of
30 the mayor's youth commission shall reflect the ethnic, racial,
31 and geographic constitution of the population of the city.
32 The adjustments to members appointed under sections 2-
33 145.A.2.a. and b. below will be made through attrition. The
34 mayor's youth commission shall include:

36 a. ~~Eleven (11)~~ Twenty (20) members between the ages
37 of fourteen (14) and eighteen (18) who reside in
38 Denver at the time of appointment;

- 1 b. ~~Five (5)~~ Four (4) members who, at the time of
2 appointment, are employees of city agencies which
3 serve ~~serving~~ or support youth; and
4
5 c. ~~Five (5)~~ Four (4) members who, at the time of
6 appointment, represent community agencies which
7 serve or support ~~serving~~ youth.
