Business, Workforce & Sustainability

- BR11-0607 Authorizes the Manager of Finance to issue for the City and County of Denver, for and on behalf of its Department of Aviation, Airport Revenue Refunding Bonds, Series 2011B-D in an amount not to exceed \$650 million for the purpose of refunding outstanding Series 1998, 2001 and 2002 Airport Revenue bonds.
- BR11-0609 Approves a \$575,000 contract amendment with Airport and Aviation professionals, Inc to extend the contract for two years for services as an Airline Liaison Office, representing the airlines' collective views while facilitating the airline/airport relationship as a business partnership.
- BR11-0610 Approves a \$378,938.00 contract amendment with the U.S. Department of Agriculture to address wildlife hazards in the vicinity of the airport.
- RR11-0611 Approves a \$600,000 contract with Denver Urban Renewal Authority to provide low or no interest rehabilitation loans to income-qualified homeowners using federal HOME funding.
- RR11-0614 Authorizes the City to roll-over to future years its 2011 Private Activity Bond allocation of \$29,385,875 from the Colorado's Department of Local Affairs .

Government & Finance

- BR11-0608 Extend for one year the contract with Community Mediation Concepts to provide mediation services for City agencies for \$8,291.67 per month while an RFP is conducted for a new contract for the citywide services.

Health, Safety, Education & Services

- BR11-0602 Accepts the FY 11-12 Incident Management Team pilot project grant award of \$250,000 from FEMA for the Office of Emergency Management

to provide regional training and exercise funds for Incident Management Teams.

- RR11- Approves the following mayoral re-appointments and new appointments

- BR11- Approves an Intergovernmental Agreement with the University of

- RR11- Grants a revocable permit to DaVita, Inc. to encroach into the public
0616 right-of-way with a permanent roof structure overhang at 2000 16th Street in Council District 9.
