

## **Committee Consent Agenda**

## **Business, Workforce & Sustainability**

BR11- Authorizes the City and County of Denver to accept 100% 0693 reimbursement in the amount of \$14,931,257 from a funding agreement with the Transportation Security Agency (TSA) for the upgrade of the Baggage Handling System (BHS) in Checked Baggage Resolution Areas (CBRA) at DIA.

## **Health, Safety, Education & Services**

BR11- Amends the Express Personnel Services contract (CE11077-01) with the Department of Human Services to add \$250,000 to the agreement for a new total contract amount of \$900,000; to provide temporary employment positions to process assistance applications.

## Land Use, Transportation & Infrastructure

- BR11- Vacates public right-of-way that is Fundy St. between 54th Pl. and 54th 0684 Ave. for construction of a private cul-de-sac in Council District 11.
- BR11- Approves the assessments for the costs related to constructing improvements within the South Broadway Streetscape (Arizona to Iowa) Local Improvement District in Council District 7.
- BR11- Approves the annual assessments for the cost of maintaining improvements in the South Broadway Streetscape (Arizona to Iowa) Local Maintenance District in Council District 7.
- BR11- Approves exclusion of land from the Lakehurst Water and Sanitation District which is located within Denver and has never received service from the District, which is primarily in Jefferson County, and agrees that Denver will continue to provide sanitary sewer service to the excluded area in Council District 2.

- BR11- Amends the existing IGA with Denver Water regarding Conduit Nos. 12 0694 and 18 crossing the South Platte River near 11th Av. to increase Denver's obligation by \$727,700, for a new total of \$2,414,132, to accommodate the City's re-channelization of the river between 8th Av. and W. Colfax in Council District 9 and approves expenditure of the additional funds.
- RR11- Dedicates a parcel of land as public right-of-way for 43rd Av., east of Sherman in Council District 9.
- RR11- Dedicates a parcel of land as public right-of-way for 44th Av. between Sherman and Pearl in Council District 9.
- RR11- Dedicates a parcel of land as public right-of-way for an alley bounded by 44th Av., 43rd Av. and Sherman in Council District 9.

Routine, non-controversial requests for ordinances that are not substantive policy changes may be placed on Consent Agendas for Council Committees each week with the approval of Committee chairs. Councilmembers receive the consent agendas for review and have until Thursday at noon to request that an item be scheduled for Committee discussion. If approved, items are placed on the Mayor-Council agenda the following week. This document outlines the items that were placed on consent agendas this week.
