**A BILL**

**For an ordinance making a cash transfer from the Risk Management Special Revenue Fund (11838) to the Capital Improvement Claims Settlement Fund (38434) and making an appropriation in the Capital Improvement Claims Settlement Fund.**

**WHEREAS**, the City recently won a subrogation claim against Union Pacific related to damage to a City bridge caused by Union Pacific's negligence; and

**WHEREAS**, said claim return was deposited back to the Risk Management Special Revenue Fund which is the centralized location to track activity related to subrogation, and

**WHEREAS**, companion ordinance 0102, series of 2024 creates a new Capital Claims Settlement Fund; and

**WHEREAS**, the City wishes to transfer the claim return to the Capital Improvement Claims Settlement Fund to be used toward bridge repairs at the location where the damage occurred;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

**Section 1:** There is hereby authorized the transfer of cash in the amount indicated in the following tabulation:
