A BILL

For an Ordinance approving an Amendatory Intergovernmental Agreement with Denver Public Schools that adds composting services to the IGA for solid waste disposal and collection and recycling services and that extends the term for 3 years.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. The proposed Ordinance approving an Amendatory Intergovernmental Agreement with Denver Public Schools and the City and County of Denver to extend the term 3 years for City collection of trash, recycling, and composting in the words and figures contained and set forth in that form of an Amendatory Intergovernmental Agreement available in the office and on the web page of City, and to be filed in the office of the Clerk and Recorder, Ex-Officio Clerk of the City and County of Denver, under City Clerk’s Filing No. 2009-0599-A is hereby approved.
