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8 Levying upon all taxable property within the City and County of Denver taxes for the  
9 year 2010 for purposes authorized by law for School District No. 1 in the City and

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12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

13 Section 1. That there is hereby levied for the year 2010 upon all taxable property within  
14 School District No. 1 in the City and County of Denver and the State of Colorado, the taxes in  
15 mills per dollar of assessed valuation, set forth in the following tabulation, the proceeds of the  
16 several levies to be paid into the respective funds named:

18 School District No. 1 in the City and County of Denver and State of Colorado:	
19 General Fund	33.172
20 Bond Redemption	6.800

21 Section 2. If any part or parts or subsection or subsections of this levying resolution shall be  
22 held to be illegal or unconstitutional, such illegality and unconstitutionality shall not affect the  
23 validity or constitutionality of the remaining parts of this levying resolution. The Council hereby  
24 declares that it would have passed the remaining parts or subsections of this resolution if it had  
25 known that such other part or parts or subsection or subsections thereof would be illegal or  
26 unconstitutional.

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This Resolution is required by law in order to levy taxes for School District No. 1.
