Rebuild existing outdated traffic signals within the City and County of Denver. All signal rebuild will be per the current Denver Traffic standards. Work will range from installation of foundation(s) to full rebuild –i.e. remove the existing traffic signal and replace with mast arm traffic signal poles, installation of 12" diameter signal indications, 16" pedestrian signals faces, pedestrian crossing stations (buttons and signs), updated controller and cabinet, Uninterrupted Power Supply(UPS), Ethernet communication equipment (switches), video detection and traffic surveillance cameras, and emergency preemption system, and traffic signs and pavement markings.
