The Denver Office of the Clerk and Recorder is seeking approval to purchase a vehicle to support election security operations. This purchase will come from the Office of Emergency Management "UASI Grant FY20" Program, approved under Resolution 1311, series of 2021, appropriation (12100/0160000). The purchase will support mobile voting options that provide greater equity, as well as backup voting opportunities if a polling place is affected by a terrorist attack or has security threats called in around it. This will allow elections to still get voting options in the area but not necessarily at the polling location. In the FY20 UASI grant Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO), there was a requirement to address voting security in the grant program. This project was submitted to the State and federal grantor; it was accepted and approved by both and meets the election security funding requirement placed on the funding by the Dept of Homeland Security. The purchase of electric vehicle options was considered but is not an available option for this type of vehicle. This equipment exceeds \$50,000, and so an ordinance is required, per the DRMC.
