13	Section 1. Section 28-21 (d), D.R.M.C., is amended by deleting the language stricken and				
14	adding the language underlined, to read as follows:				
15	Sec. 28-21 CommissionsAppointments, removal, terms.				
16	(d) The terms of the members shall be two (2) years three (3) years; the terms shall be				
17	staggered so that one-half (1/2) one third (1/3) of the members are appointed each year. In the event				
18	of the death or resignation of any member, the successor shall be appointed in the manner provided				
19	for original appointment, to serve for the unexpired portion of the term for which such member has				
20	been appointed.				
21	Section 2. Section 28-25, D.R.M.C., are amended by deleting the language stricken and				
22	adding the language underlined, to read as follows:				
23	Sec. 28-25 Advisory board—Appointments, removal, terms.				
24	(a) The advisory board shall consist of one (1) representative from each agency				
25	commission and five (5) community representatives. The Three (3) of the five (5) community				
26	representatives shall be appointed by the mayor and confirmed by council acting by resolution, and				
27	two (2) of the five (5) community representatives shall be appointed jointly by the mayor and city				
28	council and confirmed by council acting by resolution. All members shall serve in accordance				
29	with section 2.2.6 of the Charter.				
30	(b) The members shall serve without compensation, except that advisory board members				
31	may be reimbursed for expenses incurred in connection with the work of the advisory board in				
32	accordance with the Charter and Code, executive orders, fiscal rules, and city policies and as				
33	approved by the executive director.				
34	(c) The terms of the advisory board members shall be two (2) years three (3) years.				
35	(d) The terms shall be staggered so that one-half $(\frac{1}{2})$ one third $(1/3)$ of the members are				

appointed each year. In the event of the death or resignation of any member, a successor shall be

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appointed in the manner provided for original appointment, to serve for the unexpired portion of the
term for which such member has been appointed.

3 (e) The advisory board shall nominate a member to serve as chairperson who upon 4 acceptance of the nomination, confirmation by the executive director, and subject to the Charter, 5 article II of this chapter, and the advisory board's bylaws, shall serve as chair for a period of one (1) 6 year. No advisory board member elected chairperson may serve more than two (2) consecutive 7 terms as chairperson. The executive director has the right to remove the chairperson from this 8 position for cause.
