Grant funds will be used to support the park improvements at Russell Square Park, and a mini-mountain bike skills course; a camping/staging area for Genesee Park’s Challenge Course; and programs including gardening programs, afterschool programs, family workshops, expanded nature activities, youth stewardship, outdoor adventures, environmental career exposure, and more. Parks & Recreation is partnering with several non-profit and community partners for these places, pathways, and programs, with roughly \$1.2 million being passed-through to the partners.
