BR13-0297 Approves a \$1,600,000 up to five-year contract with Telos ID to provide services related to the Transportation Security Administration's mandated background checks on airport badge applicants (CE-201208848).

BR13-0298 Approves a \$582,334 contract with The Parker Company for furniture, fixtures and operating, supplies and equipment for the Denver International Airport Westin Hotel (201208377).

Government & Finance

BR13-0301 Approves a supplemental ordinance for \$705,000 to fund and implement the agreement previously passed by City Council approving a property exchange with Denver Public Schools. (Note: The City must encumber \$705,000 in order to fully execute contract 201310575, the properties have been appraised and the agreed upon difference is \$705,000 which is to be split between the Domestic Violence Partnership (\$355,000) and Denver (\$350,000). This amount was not budgeted for 2013 as the opportunity for the land exchange did not present itself until after the 2013 budget was complete).

BR13-0300 Accepts the title to Tract A of Green Valley Ranch Filing No. 56 and conveys it to School District No. 1 in the City and County of Denver for construction of a school in accordance with the subdivision rules and regulations and the Green Valley Ranch North Development Agreement in Council District 11.

BR13-0302 Approves a \$1,000,000 Master Purchase Order with Econolite Control Products, Inc. for the procurement of Traffic Signal Controller Cabinets (0264A0111).
