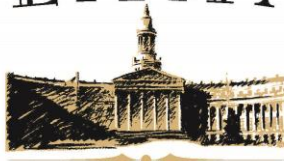


# PROCLAMATION

## Proclamation No. 17-0605

### Designating May 21 through May 27 as “Public Works Week in Denver” and Congratulating the Denver Public Works Department’s Ten Employees of the Year for 2016

**WHEREAS**, Denver Public Works employees are integral to our residents’ everyday lives, delivering services that include street sweeping, recycling and refuse collection, pothole repairs, street paving, and mobility programs supported by top-notch vehicle and equipment technicians; and

**WHEREAS**, Denver Public Works enhances the quality of life in our City by managing and maintaining public infrastructure including streets, alleys, drainage ways, sewers, bridges, traffic signals, street markings, signage and on-street parking, as well as contracting, procurement, cashing and permitting programs that meet the needs of the public; and

**WHEREAS**, Public Works would like to honor the loss of **Steve Hersey**, Director of Traffic Operations and City Traffic Engineer since 2013 whose ‘out of the box’ thinking and level headed approach will make him honorary Employee of the Year posthumously. His bright light will shine forever in our hearts; and
