The scope of this 3-year License Agreement with Veo is to operate Denver’s Shared Bike & Scooter Program beginning in May 2026. This request follows the expiration of the current license agreements with Lime and Bird in May 2026 and the execution of a new competitive procurement for the program.

The agreement allows for operating shared bikes and scooters within Denver’s public right-of-way. It includes expanded safety requirements, locked-in affordable pricing, improved parking compliance mechanisms, a more diverse and accessible vehicle fleet, and a robust Access Program providing free and discounted mobility options for income-qualified residents.

The agreement outlines operational, safety, equity, data, and compliance requirements that Veo must meet to operate Denver’s shared bike and scooter program, including devices, customer service, parking standards, reporting, and community engagement. It establishes a framework to ensure safe, equitable, and reliable service delivery while giving DOTI strong oversight, enforcement tools, and mechanisms to maintain service continuity.
