A BILL

For an ordinance making a rescission from and an appropriation in the Parks, Trails, and Open Space Special Revenue Fund; transferring cash to the Parks, Trails, and Open Space Capital Improvement Fund; and authorizing an appropriation in the Parks, Trails, and Open Space Capital Improvement Fund.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 668, Series of 2020, and Ordinance No. 1534, Series of 2021, authorized the acquisition of properties for the Sand Creek Project; and

WHEREAS, additional appropriation is required in the Parks, Trails, and Open Space Capital Projects Fund to support the land acquisitions previously authorized through said ordinances;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. From appropriations heretofore made from the Parks, Trails, and Open Space Special Revenue Fund listed or indicated in the following tabulation there is hereby RESCINDED the amount listed or indicated in such tabulation under the heading "Amount Rescinded":
