Government & Finance

BR13-0983 Approves a no-cost amendment to the contract with PropertyInfo Corporation to increase efficiencies by allowing internal City departments to electronically record documents with the Clerk and Recorder's Office free of charge and to cap the fees a contractor can charge its customers for submitting electronic docs for recording through 2016, at which time the fee will be renegotiated. The contract term remains September 30, 2018 (CLERK-201309360-01).

BR13-0986 Amends the contract with ThyssenKrupp Elevator Corporation for maintenance of elevators at the Denver Justice Center to increase the maximum contract amount by \$167,000, for a new maximum of \$567,000 to sufficiently fund the contract until the end of the contract term on May 31, 2014 (GENRL-CE86011-01).

BR13-0988 Renews the maintenance contract with Syscon Justice Systems for maintenance for the proprietary application software Jail Management System and its interfaces that support the offender management services for the Sheriff Department through 2014, and adds \$209,332 for the year, bringing the total contract amount to \$2,447,802 (CE-76012-06).

Health, Safety, Education & Services

RR13-0982 Nominates the re-appointment of Kalisha Frazier as the City Council appointment to the Head Start Policy Council for a term effective January 6, 2014 and ending November 30, 2014.

BR13-0984 Approves an agreement with Waste Management of Colorado (WM) and the City and County of Denver through December 31, 2015 for WM's operation of a composting facility at the City-owned Denver Arapahoe Disposal Site (DADS) for revenue in the amount of \$100,000 (CE-201204116).

BR13- Approves the purchase of a fire brush truck in the amount of \$293,500 to support wildland firefighting efforts. This equipment will be funded through the department's special revenue fund and therefore will have no impact to the City's general fund operations.

BR13- Approves a contract with Justice Benefits Inc. for compensation based on 8% of the total grant awarded to Denver from the State Criminal Alien Assistance Program through December 31, 2016 for their assistance to maximize grants awarded through the program (201313993).

Routine, non-controversial requests for ordinances that are not substantive policy changes may be placed on Consent Agendas for Council Committees each week with the approval of Committee chairs. Councilmembers receive the consent agendas for review and have until Thursday at noon to request that an item be scheduled for Committee discussion. If approved, items are placed on the Mayor-Council agenda the following week. This document outlines the items that were placed on consent agendas this week.
