9 **WHEREAS**, the Executive Director of Public Works of the City and County of Denver has
10 found and determined that the public use, convenience and necessity no longer requires a portion
11 of the easement in the area hereinafter described, and subject to approval by ordinance, has
12 relinquished the same;

13 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

14 **Section 1.** That the action of the Executive Director of Public Works in relinquishing a
15 portion of the easement reserved in Ordinance No. 239, Series of 1956, recorded with the Denver
16 Clerk & Recorder at Reception No. 1956041666, in the following area:

18 The south half of that vacated E Harvard Ave, as described in Ordinance 0239-1956, lying
19 interjacent to Blocks 2 and 3 of Hutchinson's University Place, recorded in Arapahoe County, State
20 of Colorado, located in the southwest quarter of Section 30, Township 4 South, Range 67 West of
21 the Sixth Principal Meridian, City and County of Denver, State of Colorado.
