A BILL

For an ordinance making an appropriation in the Capital Improvements and Capital Maintenance Fund.

WHEREAS, beginning in 2019, a large section of the La Alma Pool deck began to shift, creating a safety issue for guests; and

WHEREAS, while the pool was closed due to the pandemic, further inspection of the damage determined that the subgrade beneath the pool deck had eroded and the pool bowl was potentially at risk of failure; and

WHEREAS, a structural engineering report received in March 2022 indicates that the subgrade issues can be potentially repaired without replacement of the pool shell; and

WHEREAS, per Capital Improvement Programs Policy, this project meets the justification for use of contingency, including unanticipated serious health and/or safety hazard and unanticipated repair immediately necessary to maintain the integrity of the asset; and

WHEREAS, the funds that support the annual Capital Improvement Program have \$8,200,000 in Contingency funds available for these projects; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to use \$2,000,000 of contingency from the Capital Improvement Fund to complete design and rehabilitation of the pool with the goal that it be back in service for the 2023 outdoor aquatics season;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. From the Capital Improvements and Capital Maintenance Fund out of monies not otherwise appropriated and in addition to amounts heretofore appropriated by Ordinance No. 1284, Series of 2021, and any supplemental appropriations or rescissions, there is hereby appropriated to the appropriation accounts hereinafter designated the amount of money following such designation, to be expended for the purposes and upon the authorizations in said Ordinance set forth:
