In 2020 DPR initiated an engagement with JV LoDo Denargo LLC (c/o Golub and Company) and a newly formed Metropolitan District for the Denargo Market redevelopment, with the intent to share the cost of designing, constructing and maintaining public parks along the South Platte River on city-owned land. The Developer/Metro District already had a design team selected (Sasaki Associates) and a CM/GC General Contractor on board (Swinerton). The consultant and general contractor were both selected through a competitive process led by the Developer without DPR involvement. Upon review of their qualifications for the work, DPR found
