Business, Workforce & Sustainability

BR14-0182 Approves a contract between the City (Denver Arts & Venues) and Ad Focus for sales and sales support for signage owned and operated by Denver Arts & Venues (THTRS-201313333). Ad Focus will provide these services for the 16 months remaining on the contract with a company that has gone out of business, while a new contract is bid.

Government & Finance

BR14-0195 Approves a \$792,118 purchase order for first-year payment to Insight for new patches, fixes, enhancements and new releases for covered Microsoft products under the three-year Microsoft Enterprise Agreement (EAPPS 0000003782).

Health, Safety, Education & Services

BR14-0180 Approves an eighth amendment to the contract with Enterprise Leasing Company of Denver dba Enterprise Fleet Management to extend the term of the lease agreement for 24 months through August 31, 2016 and to add \$291,798 for a total cumulative contract of \$1,581,329 to provide leased vehicles to the Denver Police Department (CE-51316-08).

BR14-0181 Approves a contract with Alcohol Monitoring Systems, Inc. in the amount of \$1,500,000 through January 31, 2017 to provide electronic monitoring services and equipment necessary to monitor offenders under supervision with the Electronic Monitoring Program (2013-14545).

BR14-0187 Approves a contract with Excelsior Youth Centers, Inc. in the amount of \$2,840,918 through June 30, 2015 to provide placements and case management services to children in and out of home care through child welfare (2012-05739-02).

BR14- Approves a contract with El Pueblo Boys & Girls Ranch, Inc. in the amount of \$2,143,215 through June 30, 2015 to provide placements and case management services to children in and out of home care through child welfare (2012-05738-02).

BR14- Approves a contract with Savio House in the amount of \$3,581,306 through June 30, 2015 to provide placements and case management services to children in and out of home care through child welfare (2012-05743-02).

BR14- Approves a contract with Tennyson Center for Children in the amount of \$1,240,536 through June 30, 2015 to provide placements and case management services to children in and out of home care through child welfare (2012-05751-02).

BR14- Approves a contract with Families First, Inc. in the amount of \$859,628 through June 30, 2015 to provide placements and case management services to children in and out of home care through child welfare (2012-06214-02).

BR14- Approves a contract with Shiloh Home, Inc. in amount of \$818,889.96 through June 30, 2015 to provide placements and case management services to children in and out of home care through child welfare (2012-06214-02).

BR14- Approves a contract with Cornell Corrections of California, Inc. in the amount of \$541,296 through June 30, 2015 to provide placements and case management services to children in and out of home care through child welfare (2012-05752-02).

BR14- Approves a third amendment to the contract with the Colorado Coalition for the Homeless to add \$182,000 for a contract total of \$1,274,131 through December 31, 2014 to provide 40 transitional housing units and case management services to chronic and episodic homeless persons with incomes between 0-30% Area Median Incomes (AMI) (CE11116-03).

Land Use, Transportation & Infrastructure

BR14- Approves a contract between the City & County of Denver and Taubman-Cherry Creek Limited Partnership to upsize a storm sewer and abandon a permanent easement at 2nd and Columbine to University Boulevard at Cherry Creek via University Boulevard in Council District 10 (201415154).

BR14- Grants a revocable permit, subject to certain terms and conditions, to Auraria Higher Education Center, their successors and assigns, to

encroach into the right-of-way with a 140' long, 18" high seat wall into 5th Street near Walnut Street in Council District 9.

- RR14-0183 Dedicates City owned land as East 39th Avenue located near the intersection of East 39th and Ulster Street in Council District 11.
- RR14-0184 Dedicates City owned land as South Grant Street located near the intersection of South Grant Street and Arizona Avenue in Council District 7.
- RR14-0185 Dedicates City owned land as North Quebec Street located near the intersection of North Quebec Street and Northfield Boulevard in Council District 11.
- RR14-0186 Dedicates a parcel of land as public right of way as Zuni Street located near the intersection of West 28th Avenue and Zuni Street in Council District 9.
