concerning public display and consumption of marijuana (if the Robb amendment is not adopted)

I move to amend CB13-0736 in the following particulars:

- 1. On Page 2, Line 8, insert the words "For purposes of this subsection and subsection (c):"
- 2. On Page 2, Line 23, insert a new subsection (c) to read as follows:
- (b) It shall be unlawful for any person within one thousand feet of the perimeter of any public or private elementary school, middle school, junior high school, or high school:
 - (1) To openly and publicly consume one ounce or less of marijuana in any outdoor location; or
 - (2) To display, transfer, distribute, sell, or grow marijuana upon any city-owned street or sidewalk or upon any other property owned by the city.
 - 3. On page 4, Line 1, in subsection (e) following the words "Any violation of subsection (b)" insert "or (c)"
 - 4. Make conforming formatting amendments as necessary.

PURPOSE OF THE AMENDMENT

- Creates a 1,000-foot buffer around the perimeter of any of the listed types of schools in which it is illegal
 - to openly and publicly consume marijuana outdoors;
 - to display, transfer, distribute, sell, or grow marijuana upon city-owned property, including public streets and sidewalks.
- Includes violation of this prohibition as a civil violation with the same escalating fines for first and subsequent violations established for other violations identified in the bill.
