## Committee Consent Agenda

### **Business, Workforce & Sustainability**

- BR14-0464 Authorizes the expenditure of \$7.3 million in federal funds for case management in the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) Employment and Training Program through 6-30-15.
- BR14-0476 Approves an Office of Economic Development \$620,000 contract with Volunteers of America - Colorado Branch to acquire land for an early childhood education center at 5000 W. Alameda Ave. in the Westwood neighborhood, located in Council District 3.

### **Health, Safety, Education & Services**

- BR14-0468 Accepts the Continuum of Care (CoC) Housing First grant award from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) in the amount of \$1,991,880 for the term 4-1-14 through 3-31-15 to provide rental assistance for 240 housing units to members of the chronically homeless population.

### **Land Use, Transportation & Infrastructure**

- BR14-0473 Approves a contract with ThyssenKrup Elevator Corporation in the amount of \$538,906 for installation of a fourth elevator in the Lindsey-Flanigan Courthouse building (Contract Control # 201415648).
- RR14-0465 Dedicates a parcel of land located between Downing Street, Corona Street, 14th Avenue, and Downing Street as a public right-of-way as a public alley in Council District 10.
- RR14-0466 Sets a public hearing regarding the service plans for the formation and establishment of Globeville Commerce Center Metropolitan District #1 and Globeville Commerce Center Metropolitan District #2.
- RR14- Grants a revocable Major Encumbrance Permit to Sister of Charity of

0467 Leavenworth Health System to encroach into the right-of-way with 25 various types of signs around the Exempla Saint Joseph Heritage Campus from Emerson Street to Franklin Street and 18th Avenue to 21st Avenue in Council District 8.

Routine, non-controversial requests for ordinances that are not substantive policy changes may be placed on Consent Agendas for Council Committees each week with the approval of Committee chairs. Councilmembers receive the consent agendas for review and have until Thursday at noon to request that an item be scheduled for Committee discussion. If approved, items are placed on the Mayor-Council agenda the following week. This document outlines the items that were placed on consent agendas this week.
