**6. General description of proposed ordinance including contract scope of work if applicable:**

This ordinance establishes a capital grant fund number and appropriates \$1,275,000 to be received from the Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) as part of the SHE (Safety Hazard Elimination) program. These funds will be used for the design and reconstruction of two (2) traffic signals within the City and County of Denver. The scope of work include new traffic poles, mast arms, controllers, UPS, Ethernet switches, cabinets and bases, conduits, signal and pedestrian displays, and traffic signs and striping. Civil works are also included in the scope to upgrade ADA ramps, sidewalk, medians, curb and gutters, and travel lanes to meet federal standards. The project is located at (1) Sheridan Boulevard at Colfax Avenue; and (2) Federal Boulevard at Evans Avenue.

This ordinance will set up a capital grant fund and appropriate the budget for this grant as follows:

**Background:**

This is a continuation of the existing SHE (Safety Hazard Elimination) grant program from CDOT for safety upgrades of various signals throughout the City. The City has received various amounts of yearly funding from this program over the last few years, and this particular contract with Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) allows the City to receive and expend federal and state fund in the amount of \$1,275,000.00 for the design and reconstruction of two traffic signals within the City and County of Denver – Sheridan Boulevard at Colfax Avenue and Federal Boulevard at Evans Avenue. The scope of work include the installation of new traffic signal poles, mast arms, controllers, cabinets and bases, UPS, Ethernet switches, signal and pedestrian displays, and traffic signs and pavement markings. In addition, new ADA ramps, sidewalks, medians, curb and gutters, and standard travel roadway lanes are also included in the scope of work.

The total federal and state funds receive from this contract is \$1,275,000.00. There is no City on this project.

The locations of these signals were approved in the 2013-2015 SHE program.

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
