A BILL

For an ordinance increasing the term of commission members from two years to three years.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. Section 28-21 (d), D.R.M.C., is amended by deleting the language stricken and adding the language underlined, to read as follows:

Sec. 28-21. - Commissions--Appointments, removal, terms.

(d) The terms of the members shall be ~~two (2) years~~ three (3) years; the terms shall be staggered so that ~~one-half (1/2)~~ one third (1/3) of the members are appointed each year. In the event of the death or resignation of any member, the successor shall be appointed in the manner provided for original appointment, to serve for the unexpired portion of the term for which such member has been appointed.
