6. General description of proposed ordinance including contract scope of work if applicable:

This ordinance will allow Zonar Systems to provide and install electronic devices that simplify and verify the required pre- and post- trip inspection process for drivers, increasing safety and ensuring compliance with DOT regulations that call for inspecting vehicles before their operation on public roadways. Contract covers the purchase and installation of the inspection hardware, annual software subscription (yearly service, updates, and customer service), custom development, field support, and applications that allow for 2-way communications and enhanced vehicle routing capabilities. Additional benefits of system include GPS technology, idling detection, reduced paper costs, and real-time reporting of vehicle evaluations. Public Works will be pursuing reimbursement of the cost of purchase and installation of the units from the Regional Air Quality Council, up to approximately \$180,000.
