A BILL

For an ordinance amending the classification and pay plan for employees in the Career Service and for certain employees not in the Career Service.

WHEREAS, pursuant to 9.1.1 (C) and (D) of the Charter and Article I of Chapter 18, D.R.M.C., the Career Service Authority has recommended to the City Council an amendment to the classification and pay plan governing the compensation of employees in the career service and certain employees not in the career service;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. That effective **March 18, 2012**, the classification and pay plan is hereby amended by adding the following job titles and associated pay grades, to read as follows:

<u>Job Title</u>	<u>Pay Grade</u>
Chief Combination Inspector	812-T
Combination Inspector I	622-T
Combination Inspector II	624-T
Trades Inspector	621-T

Section 2. That effective **March 18, 2012**, the classification and pay plan is hereby amended by deleting the following job titles and associated pay grades:

<u>Job Title</u>	<u>Pay Grade</u>
Public Safety Inspector	621-T

Section 3. That the foregoing amendments shall be reflected in the full classification and pay plan kept and maintained in the office of the Clerk and Recorder, as reflected at Clerk Filing No. 11-330-M, and at the Career Service Authority, and shall be available for public inspection both in person and on-line.
