Amends an intergovernmental agreement with the State of Colorado Division of Youth Corrections by amending the amount of funding that comes from Youth Detention Continuum (YDC) and Marijuana Tax Revenue (MTR) by increasing MTR funding by \$116,734 and decreasing the allocation from YDC by the same amount to perform detention screening and pre-trial release services for the 2nd Judicial District Senate Bill 94 Program - a statewide initiative that appropriates funds to reduce the length of time a juvenile is held in detention or a commitment facility. No change to agreement amount or duration (SAFTY-2022056251-01).
