5 **A BILL**

6 **For an ordinance amending Article XIII of Chapter 55, section 55-394, Denver**
7 **Revised Municipal Code concerning the licensing of Pedal- Cabs.**

9 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

10 **Section 1.** That sections 55-394 D.R.M.C. shall be amended by deleting the language stricken
11 and the addition of the language underlined to read as follows:

12 **Denver, Colorado, Code of Ordinances >> TITLE II - REVISED MUNICIPAL CODE >> Chapter**
13 **55 - TRANSPORTATION AND MOTOR VEHICLES; SALES AND SERVICE >> ARTICLE XIII. -**
14 **PEDAL-CABS >> DIVISION 2. - LICENSES >>**

16 Sec. 55-394. - Insurance prerequisite.

18 It shall be unlawful for any person to operate a pedal-cab business unless currently insured by
19 a reputable insurance company, said policy providing insurance coverage for each and every pedal-
20 cab owned, operated or leased by said person for injury to or death of persons in accidents resulting
21 from any cause for which said person would be liable on account of any liability imposed on him by
22 law, regardless of whether the said pedal-cab was being driven by the owner, his agent or lessee; and
23 as against damage to the property of another, including personal property, under like circumstances;
24 in the The Director shall determine and set the minimum insurance limits. However, the minimum
25 insurance shall not be decreased below the following minimum limits: Bodily injury, one hundred
26 thousand dollars (\$100,000.00) each person, three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000.00) each
27 accident; property damage, fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00). The Director may change the
28 minimum insurance limits through the adoption of rules and regulations in accordance with this article.
29 The Director shall notify City Council in writing of any proposed rules and regulations to change the
30 minimum limits.
