Sec. 55-394. - Insurance prerequisite.

It shall be unlawful for any person to operate a pedal-cab business unless currently insured by a reputable insurance company, said policy providing insurance coverage for each and every pedal-cab owned, operated or leased by said person for injury to or death of persons in accidents resulting from any cause for which said person would be liable on account of any liability imposed on him by law, regardless of whether the said pedal-cab was being driven by the owner, his agent or lessee; and as against damage to the property of another, including personal property, under like circumstances; in the The Director shall determine and set the minimum insurance limits. However, the minimum insurance shall not be decreased below the following minimum limits: Bodily injury, one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00) each person, three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000.00) each accident; property damage, fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00). The Director may change the minimum insurance limits through the adoption of rules and regulations in accordance with this article. The Director shall notify City Council in writing of any proposed rules and regulations to change the minimum limits.
