Department of Transportation and Infrastructure (DOTI) On-call Land Surveying Professional Services Contract

DOTI is seeking to establish a group of qualified On-Call Professional Land Surveying firms available to respond to proposal requests for the execution of professional land surveying work for the City's infrastructure needs.

Purpose and Use of Agreements:

The goal of this Project is to: Award multiple contracts for Professional Land Surveying Services to support all divisions of the department, including all capital infrastructure, facilities, wastewater and transportations portfolios and other City Agencies as necessary.

These professional services are in support of improvements that may include but are not limited to: preconstruction services; roadway construction; bridge construction; pavement rehabilitation; bike lane construction; signing and striping construction; traffic signal, lighting, and telecommunication construction; and storm sewer and sanitary sewer construction.

Procurement:

Fourteen (14) firms submitted qualification submittals which were reviewed and scored. Of those submittals, four (4) firms were selected.

Contracts Description:

Each contract has a three (3) year term, a capacity of \$2.5 million and an MWBE goal of 20%. The firms selected for these agreements are listed alphabetically.

These contracts do not commit funds, nor do they guarantee any amount to the firms. These contracts are not an authorization of work. Authorization or work and commitment of funds are made via work order on an as needed basis.
