a. Scope of Work

The amendment:

- Provides new pricing at a lower daily monitoring cost to the City for all existing equipment, increase shelf allowance for equipment, allows for complete lost/damage along with no cost for consumable supplies. Additionally, provides pricing for the new TAD/Cell device.
- Extends the contract terms from 6/1/11 to 5/31/13.
- Adds \$200,000.00 to the current agreement

The requested amendment allows the following:

- Allows the City and County of Denver's Electronic Monitoring Program to provide complete electronic monitoring services to Denver's Court, Probation Department and Sheriff's Department.
- Promotes public safety by utilizing various technologies to enhance supervision of offenders in the community.
