This amendment will incrementally fund an additional \$100,000 to provide energy efficiency services for residential units in the City and County of Denver. DOSP currently experienced a contract termination from Veterans Green Jobs and DOSP has received approval from the Facilities & Energy Efficiency Advisory Board to reallocate the funds to our existing contractor (MHYC).
