**6. General description of proposed ordinance including contract scope of work if applicable:**

This Ordinance will authorize the appropriation of the 2<sup>nd</sup> allocation for the 2011 funding of the Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) authorized by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. Awarded annually, the Emergency Solutions Grant has provided a stable source of funds to help meet emergency services needed to address the amelioration of poverty. The grant program operates on a fiscal year beginning January 1st. For FY 2011, Denver Human Services has been awarded a grant in the amount of \$389,480. Based on the Letter of Intent, Human Services expects to receive an additional \$219,083 from a second allocation that is authorized by HUD. The official grant award letter is not expected to be received until January 2012.
