**A BILL**

6 **For an ordinance amending the classification and pay plan for employees in the**  
7 **Career Service and for certain employees not in the Career Service.**

9 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to section 9.1.1 (C) and (D) of the Charter and Article I of Chapter 18,  
10 D.R.M.C., the Office of Human Resources has recommended to the City Council an amendment to  
11 the classification and pay plan governing the compensation of employees in the career service and  
12 certain employees not in the career service;

13 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF**  
14 **DENVER:**

15 **Section 1.** That effective **beginning of the first work week following approval by the**  
16 **Mayor or by the City Council over the Mayor’s veto**, the classification and pay plan is hereby  
17 amended by changing the title:

Solid Waste Collection Operator	Waste Services Operator I

23 **Mayor or by the City Council over the Mayor’s veto**, the classification and pay plan is hereby  
24 amended by creating the following classification:

<u>New Classification</u>	<u>Pay Grade</u>
Waste Services Operator II	NE-13
