**A BILL**

**For an ordinance authorizing a capital equipment purchase from the Denver Human Services Special Revenue Fund (SRF 13008).**

**WHEREAS**, Denver Human Services (DHS) is seeking approval for a capital equipment purchase of a replacement pickup truck with lift bed to support various agency needs including delivery and relocation of items, furniture, and food for client service programs; and

**WHEREAS**, said vehicle will replace an older truck that is beyond its useful life, creating maintenance challenges due to costs and parts availability; and

**WHEREAS**, said vehicle will be stored in the security-controlled garage of the Richard T. Castro Building campus located at 1200 Federal Boulevard; and

**WHEREAS**, said replacement vehicle is approved to be purchased from the Denver Human Services Special Revenue Fund (13008); and

**WHEREAS**, because this is a capital equipment purchase above the fifty-thousand-dollar threshold, DHS requires City Council authorization to purchase said vehicle;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

**Section 1.** From the Denver Human Services Special Revenue Fund (13008), the Chief Financial Officer, or duly authorized representatives, is hereby authorized to purchase or acquire the following capital equipment:

The foregoing vehicle purchase is to support the operations of the Denver Human Services.
