This ordinance will authorize a twelve-month contract January 1, 2011 through December 31, 2011 to provide dollars to the Colorado Coalition for the Homeless for street outreach services to homeless persons in Denver. The total contract amount is \$934,631.

Outreach services will engage people who are living / sleeping on the streets and in shelters and assist them in acquiring benefits and identifying needs (Mental Health, Substance Abuse and Health Care) so that they can move into more stable and permanent housing. 190 adults and 90 youth will be housed or reunified with their families during the contract period. A collaborative of agencies will work together to support this goal. This includes Urban Peak, Downtown Denver Business Partnership, St Francis Center and the Denver Police Department.
