9	WHEREAS, under C.R.S. § 8-20.5-101 et seq. owners and operators of petroleum storage
10	tanks who remediate releases in compliance with applicable federal and state laws and regulations
11	may apply for reimbursement of costs incurred consistent with the above-referenced statute
12	(referred to as the "Statute");
13	WHEREAS, the City periodically submits applications to the Colorado Petroleum Storage
14	Tank Fund for reimbursement of expenses the City incurs in remediating petroleum contamination
15	as provided for in the Statute;
16	WHEREAS, under the current application, the City is requesting reimbursement of One
17	Hundred Forty-Two Thousand, One-Hundred Twenty-Three and 58/100 Dollars (\$142,123.58) for
18	funds expended the site known as Fire Station 28, located at 4306 South Wolff Street, Denver,
19	Colorado ("Site");
20	WHEREAS, the City has received reimbursement totaling Eight Hundred Twenty-Two
21	Thousand, Nine Hundred Sixty-Four and 44/100 Dollars (\$822,964.44) for remediation activities at
22	the Site and together the amount requested in the current application and the previous
23	reimbursement amounts exceed Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000); and
24	WHEREAS, the City anticipates seeking future reimbursement of expenses not to exceed
25	the current statutory limits of \$2,000,000 for this site under the Statute.
26	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF
27	DENVER:
28	Section 1. The proposed Supplemental Reimbursement Application to the Colorado
29	Petroleum Storage Tank Fund in the words and figures contained and set forth in that form of
30	application filed in the office of the City Clerk of the City and County of Denver, on May 24, 2012,
31	City Clerk's Filing No. 2009-0386-C is hereby approved.
32	Section 2. The Mayor or his lawful successor and other proper officials of the City and
33	County of Denver, in its behalf, and without further action by City Council, are hereby authorized to
34	execute future Supplemental Reimbursement Applications to the Colorado Petroleum Storage Tank
35	Fund up to the statutory limits pursuant to C.R.S. § 8-20.5-101 et seq. for reimbursement of
36	remediation activities conducted at the site known as Fire Station #28, located at 4306 South Wolff
37	Street, Denver, Colorado.
