6. General description of proposed ordinance including contract scope of work if applicable:

Ordinance number 325, series 1990, required the Denver Public Library to have a minimum of 600 parking spaces. That number was reduced to 435 by ordinance 412, series 1996.

In accordance with the current zoning code, which allows for a 25% parking space reduction for properties located within a mass transit corridor, this ordinance amendment requests the 25% reduction be applied to the Denver Public Library. This proposed amendment would reduce the number of parking spaces required for the Denver Public Library to 326.

The parking spaces are located within the parking garage on the northwest corner of 12th and Broadway, also known as the DAM Parking garage.

This 25% parking reduction has already been approved for other users of the parking garage including the Hamilton Art Museum and the Clyfford Still Museum.
