Executive Summary

An ordinance to authorize Public Works to obtain two (2) Caterpillar 160 M2 Road Graders from Wagner Equipment Co. financed through a companion capital lease purchase agreement with Chase Equipment Finance, Inc.

The City and County of Denver is seeking to purchase two (2) Caterpillar 160 M2 Road Graders from WAGNER EQUIPMENT CO. The proposed agreement is a zero dollar agreement that will allow the City to obtain the equipment and a companion agreement with Chase Equipment Finance, Inc., who is the financier. The cost of the equipment is \$597,192.00.
