

# **Technology Employment in Colorado Partnership (TEC-P)**

#### **Overview**

- USDOL Grant
- \$7.38m, 4-year period of performance (1/31/25)
- 750 participants served
- Building a talent pipeline for IT, Advanced Manufacturing and Transportation careers

#### To Date

- 876 participants served
- 91% receiving training
- 57% non-white, 34% female


