BY AUTHORITY ORDINANCE NO. COUNCIL BILL NO. CB13-0685 SERIES OF 2013 **COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE:** Land Use, Transportation & Infrastructure ABILL For an ordinance establishing the "Downtown Denver Improvements" fund in

the Grant/Other Capital Projects Funds.

WHEREAS, the "Downtown Denver Improvements" fund will allow capital appropriations to be made based upon Denver Urban Renewal Authority (DURA) projected property tax increment revenues from certain Downtown property tax increment areas, projected sales tax revenues from certain Downtown sales tax increment areas, and appropriated Sheridan lodger's tax based revenues as provided in the Amended and Restated Cooperation Agreement for Downtown Denver Urban Redevelopment Area Projects and the Project Funding Agreement for Downtown Denver Improvements; and

WHEREAS, this is a companion ordinance to accompany the Council Bills to approve the Amended and Restated Cooperation Agreement for Downtown Denver Urban Redevelopment Area Projects (Cooperation Agreement) and the Project Funding Agreement for Downtown Denver Improvements (Project Funding Agreement) between the City and County of Denver and DURA (CB13-0683 and CB13-0684 respectively) to further the objectives of the Urban Renewal Plan for Downtown Denver Urban Redevelopment Projects (Downtown Urban Redevelopment Plan);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. There is hereby established in the Grants/Other Capital Projects Fund, Accounting No. 38000, the "Downtown Denver Improvements" Program, Accounting No. 38367-5011102-PN019, for the purpose of accepting revenues, appropriating and expending said revenues received from DURA for the implementation of projects to further the objectives of the Downtown Urban Renewal Plan, as governed by the Project Funding Agreement.

Section 2. Monies to this fund shall be deposited into the Treasury of the City and credited to Special Fund No. 38000, which is set forth and described in Section 20-18 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver.

Section 3. There is hereby appropriated to the appropriation account hereinafter designated the amounts of money following each such designation, to be expended for the purposes and upon the authorizations in said Ordinance set forth:

The foregoing appropriation is to provide funding for projects to further the objective of the Downtown Urban Renewal Plan.

Section 4. Expenditures are hereby authorized for the "Downtown Denver Improvements" Program, Accounting No. 38367. The Department of Finance is hereby authorized to adjust the appropriations during the term of the Project Funding Agreement, based upon annual DURA revenue projections; provided that the appropriations are <u>never to exceed</u> the amount of tax increment revenue actually received from DURA through reimbursement of actual project invoices expended by the Manager of Public Works.
