# 5. Describe the proposed ordinance, including what the proposed ordinance is intended to accomplish, who's involved

#### a. Scope of Work

This ordinance establishes a capital grant fund number and appropriates \$1,275,000 to be received from the Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) as part of the SHE (Safety Hazard Elimination) program. These funds will be used for the design and reconstruction of two (2) traffic signals within the City and County of Denver. The scope of work include new traffic poles, mast arms, controllers, UPS, Ethernet switches, cabinets and bases, conduits, signal and pedestrian displays, and traffic signs and striping. Civil works are also included in the scope to upgrade ADA ramps, sidewalk, medians, curb and gutters, and travel lanes to meet federal standards.
