Business Development

- RR16- Approves a contract with Panasonic Enterprise Solution Company in the amount of \$5 million and for three years in duration to provide professional services to support innovative technology based solutions related to the planning and implementation of technical initiatives, taking into account operational, environmental, and financial considerations (PLANE 201626296).
- RR16- Approves a contract with GCR, Inc. in the amount of \$5 million and for three years in duration to provide professional services to support innovative technology based solutions related to the planning and implementation of technical initiatives, taking into account operational, environmental, and financial considerations (PLANE 201626261).
- RR16- Approves a contract with SITA Information Networking Computing USA, 0095 Inc. in the amount of \$5 million and for three years in duration to provide professional services to support innovative technology based solutions related to the planning and implementation of technical initiatives, taking into account operational, environmental, and financial considerations (PLANE 201626228).

Infrastructure & Culture

- BR16- Approves renaming Rifle Street at Buckley Road, bounded by Tower 0078 Road, and approximately 62nd Avenue and 60th Avenue as Panasonic Way in Council District 11.
- RR16- Approves a \$1,008,055 contract with OZ Architecture for a contract term ending 9-30-18 for design and construction services for the relocation of the 911 Communication Center to 12025 East 45th Avenue in Council District 8 (201626298).
- RR16- Dedicates a parcel of land as right-of-way as a public alley at the one intersection of East 2nd Avenue and Milwaukee Street in Council District

- RR16- Grants a revocable permit to Denver Bike Sharing to encroach into the 0091 right-of-way with a bicycle docking station at 1218 21st Street in Council District 9.
- RR16- Approves a no-cost extension of the contract with CH2M Hill Engineers, 0097 Inc. for 23 months through 12-31-17 to complete the Brighton Boulevard 29th to 44th streets design and post design services in Council District 9 (201418034).
- RR16- Approves the \$3,958,461.60 purchase of sixteen Peterbilt 320/ Amrep 0100 body barrel loading refuse trucks from Rush Peterbilt Truck Center to replace old vehicles and expand the recycling and mulching programs.

BR16- Amends the Classification and Pay Plan by adding Golf Cart Attendant and Golf Sales Associate creating two new golf classes. Employees in these classes are on-call employees.

Safety & Well-being

- BR16- Approves an appropriation of \$150,000 for the Emergency Management 0096 Performance Grant from the State of Colorado and Department of Homeland Security.
- RR16- Amends a contract with LT Environmental, Inc. by adding \$480,000 for 0088 a new amount not to exceed \$960,000 and extend the term to 4-8-18 to complete on-call environmental consulting projects for the City (#ENVHL-201520849).
- RR16- Approves the \$2,032,807 purchase of sixty-four Police and Sheriff 0098 Intercepors from Sill-Tehar Motors.
- RR16- Approves a \$1,886,437.80 contract with Pierce Manufacturing for the manufacture and delivery of one Pierce Velocity 105' Ladder Truck and two Pierce Velocity Pumpers.
