This request is for the donation of City surplus personal computers to PCs for People. These PCs were previously used by City employees for normal City operations and have now reached end of life for City business purposes. PCs for People shall remove all City data from the hard drives prior to distribution. By donating this equipment, the City will also save approximately \$5,000 in recycling cost.

Founded in 1998, PCs for People is a national leader in digital inclusion. As a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization, every project, program and initiative at PCs for People is centered on getting low-cost computers and affordable broadband internet into the homes of low-income individuals. Through an unwavering commitment to the communities they serve, they have distributed over 80,000 computers, subscribed thousands of families to low-cost internet, and recycled millions of pounds of electronics. Digital inclusion efforts such as theirs are essential in today's society, where it is increasingly hard to access education, healthcare or employment opportunities without access to a computer or the internet. Their model is a self-sustainable social enterprise centered on building community value in every part of our program. They are the only Minnesota recycler and one of two in Colorado with both the R2 and NAID AAA recycling certifications.
