 - a. Scope of Work

Proposed ordinance will increase by \$1 million the overall capacity for Parks and Recreation's on-call landscape improvements and irrigation construction contractor. Contract 201204313 T2 Construction was awarded a \$1.5 million maximum capacity contract, along with five other contractors in January 2012 through a competitive RFP process. As of September 2012, distinct project bid solicitations under this contract, none of which may exceed an engineer's estimate of \$400,000, have been awarded such that remaining contract balance for T2 Construction is currently less than \$700,000 due to this firm's aggressive, competitive bidding. This contract does not expire until January 2015. Increasing the contract capacity for T2 Construction will allow Parks and Recreation to complete work in the most cost effective manner and to maintain a competitive pool of on-calls.
