This is one of three resolution requests to authorize three separate components of the Denver's 2022 mill levy for property taxes due in 2023: 1) City, 2) DPS, 3) and Special Districts (this request). Per the special session that convened on November 17, 2023, and Senate Bill 23B-001, the calendar requirements for authorizing the City's mill levies in 2023 for property taxes payable in 2024 have been revised as follows:

- Wednesday, January 3: Deadline for Assessor to complete the final certification.
- Wednesday, January 10: Deadline for DPS and special districts to submit their mill levies.
- Wednesday, January 17: Deadline for City Council to authorize 2023 mill levies, payable in 2024.
