A BILL

For an ordinance authorizing a rescission and an appropriation in the Climate Protection Special Revenue Fund to make a cash transfer to the Climate Protection Capital Projects Fund.

WHEREAS, the Denver Regional Transportation District (RTD) and the City and County of Denver (CCD) are planning to develop Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) along the East Colfax Avenue corridor from Downtown Denver to the R Line light rail station in Aurora; and

WHEREAS, funding for this project will come from a variety of sources, including a Federal Transit Administration (FTA) "Small Starts Grant"; and

WHEREAS, receipt of said grant funds is contingent on the City and County of Denver providing a local match, which is included as part of the adopted 2024 Budget; and

WHEREAS, the Office of Climate Action, Sustainability, and Resilience has committed \$6,000,000 of Climate Protection Funds for the BRT Capital Project, which promotes sustainable transportation; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to make a rescission from and an appropriation in the Climate Protection Fund to make a cash transfer to the Climate Protection Capital Projects Fund to support the 2024 Colfax BRT Project appropriation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. From appropriations heretofore made from the Climate Protection Special Revenue Fund, Accounting No. 11880, listed or indicated in the following tabulation there is hereby RESCINDED the amount listed or indicated in such tabulation under the heading "Amount Rescinded":
