 - a. Scope of Work**

This is a 100% reimbursement funding agreement with the TSA to upgrade the BHS checked baggage resolution areas (CBRA) within the Terminal building and adjacent garages on level three. The work consists of design, construction, and project execution to upgrade and improve the working conditions for TSA personnel staffing the CBRAs. The proposed upgrade described in the Other Transaction Agreement will also increase capacity and improve the equipment of the odd size system in three locations in the terminal.
