Grant (2014-AJ-BX-0014) under CFDA # 16.817 awards the Denver Police Department the amount of \$999,982.00

The Sun Valley Partnership Policing Project will coordinate through Community Partnerships with Denver Juvenile TASC, Servicios, and the Health Resources Consortium in the planning and implementation of a comprehensive set of essential services, augmented by targeted police strategies and presence.

Project Goals:

- 1) Increase community involvement in crime prevention and reduction;
- 2) Increase community safety in collaboration with CNI community revitalization efforts and through tactical police enforcement; and
- 3) Decrease crime rates through implementation of integrated public safety activities with community, social and judicial resources.
- 6) Reduce calls for service in highly monitored areas by 33 percent; and
- 7) Reduce criminal behavior/conduct among Sun Valley community members by 15 percent.

- 1) Improve residents' perceptions of law enforcement effectiveness and fairness by 20 percent;
- 2) Increase community reports of crime by 25 percent;
- 3) Increase businesses and residences that have crime deterring infrastructure in place;
- 4) Improve clearance rates for crime (i.e., crimes have been resolved by law enforcement) by 25 percent;
- 5) Reduce truancy among Sun Valley youth by 15 percent;
